
Thank you to RS Forum Hosts Sunbeam School Lahartara

Tuesdays - RS Worldwide Show & Tell.

- One session per month at 2am GMT (will increase to twice if there is demand)
- Two sessions per month at 2pm GMT
- Ages 8-10 years

These 60-minute Zoom calls connect students aged 8-10 with peers from across the globe, inviting them to share perspectives and experiences through a show-and-tell format.

Wednesdays - RS Zoom Postcards

• Two postcards each week

These interactive, student-led conversations connect your young people with peers from up to 30 different schools, offering insights into everything from cultural traditions and favourite recipes to pressing global issues like climate change and social justice.

Thursdays - RS Study Labs

- Ages 14+
- Usually 4am GMT and 3pm GMT.
- Timings may vary between Study Lab series for different languages

Designed to nurture leadership, deepen understanding of international perspectives, and build cross-cultural connections, Study Labs create a space for students to explore curriculum topics in meaningful, relevant ways. Each 60–90 minute session is entirely student-led, and while participants are encouraged to follow the full programme, sessions can also be attended individually.

The sessions are run over consecutive weekly one-hour slots. This allows their peers in Round Square schools around the world to practice their language skills in a real-world context.

Participants are grouped by ability—beginner, intermediate, and advanced—ensuring that each session is appropriately tailored in complexity and content for every level.

There is one more session planned between now and the end of the year:


